Supreme Leader Kim Jong Un Inspects Construction Sites in Samjiyon County Again

The respected Supreme Leader **Kim Jong Un**, with his wife Ri Sol Ju, gave field guidance to the construction sites in Samjiyon County again.

He said he came to the construction sites in Samjiyon township just in 40 days but the area has changed beyond recognition, noting with satisfaction that a majestic appearance finally began to emerge as a result of the dynamic struggle of the builders who upheld the Party's intention with loyalty like a white gem to face-lift Samjiyon County where the native home of the revolution is located into a rare modern city in the mountainous area in the era of the Workers' Party.

This year marking the 70th founding anniversary of the DPRK, dramatic changes are witnessed in the construction sites of Samjiyon County, the Wonsan-Kalma coastal tourist area, power station and others across the country and thus enormous edifices mushroom, and numerous units vie with one another in making big successes, he noted.

Now the hostile forces' persistent sanctions and obstructive moves come as a serious setback to the advance of our socialism but the zeal of the elated people who rose up like a mountain in response to the Party's call is making a history of legendary miracles despite the most difficult conditions, he said, adding with great pride that this is a great manifestation of the high spirit of our army and people and the power of our country where everybody gets united in single mind around the Party.

We mustn't regard it as a mere construction to remodel the county housing the native home of the revolution but keep a high sense of class consciousness that the construction is like an acute standoff with hostile forces and showily build a modern city in the mountainous area overflowing with our socialist civilization in the first village right at the foot of Mt Paektu, he stressed.

Once again emphasizing that the education space with the statue of leader **Kim Jong Il** should be well built with due respect, he learned about the layout of the background forest of the statue, an assignment he gave one month ago, and about the measures for its implementation.

This construction in the northern area to which the Party attaches so much importance is not just aimed to spruce up Samjiyon County alone but it is an important work to create experience and set an example in setting the future goal of face-lifting all the counties to be highly civilized ones, he said. He added that counties in our country have shown great difference in their development due to differing natural and geographic features and economic conditions, stressing the need to create models by sprucing up standard counties and build model counties in the flat areas, mountainous areas and coastal areas before generalizing them.

He then went round the construction sites of dwelling houses and public buildings in the township, learning in detail about the overall construction.

Highlighting the importance of good designing of afforestation and greening, he called for combining trees of various species to be in good harmony with the mountainous area of Mt Paektu so as to create a model in turning towns into park-like woodland.

He also advanced tasks for sprucing up the County People's Hospital to be flawless in health and sanitation terms.

He urged the need to take scientific and technological measures to ensure the standard quality of drinking water and water for living supplied to inhabitants in Samjiyon area, and thus to solve the water problem without fail.

He also stressed the need to redo the railway roadbed repairing work in a qualitative way by next year to complete Hyesan-Samjiyon railway as a standard one, pointing out the fault that on his way to Samjiyon he could see that the newly paved Hyesan-Samjiyon railway section roadbed was not done well and scientific measurement and the requirement of technical method of construction was not ensured in terms of roadbed condition and evenness so that serious vibration could be felt on train and its speed was impeded.

Calling for making the builders and skilled men acquire one step higher grade in the course of doing such a huge project as the construction of Samjiyon area and for rapidly strengthening the construction and designing force of the local areas, he underlined the importance to organize in a planned way with big efforts the work for strengthening construction technicians.

He made the particular mention of the role the provincial Party committee plays in taking control of the work of enhancing the level of designing institutions in the local areas.

He repeatedly stressed the importance to take measures against all kinds of accidents while doing projects as required by the method of construction by design and thus prevent even a single accident.

He also mentioned the need to make good calculation of the total electricity demand to be needed by the county after its rebuilding, calling for readjusting and reinforcing the existent small and medium power stations in Samjiyon County and meticulously organizing their management and operation so as to increase electricity production by the county itself.

Looking at the stirring construction site, he said that the whole country is devoting pure conscience and sweats of obligation to sprucing up the county housing the native home of leader **Kim Jong Il** as their own house at the call of the Party, and warmly asked to convey his comradely greetings to all the builders surely.

Supreme Leader Kim Jong Un Inspects Myohyangsan Medical Appliances Factory

Kim Jong Un, chairman of the Workers' Party of Korea, chairman of the State Affairs Commission of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and supreme commander of the Korean People's Army, inspected the Myohyangsan Medical Appliances Factory.

Looking round the room for education in the revolutionary history, sci-tech learning space and various workshops of the factory, the respected Supreme Leader **Kim Jong Un** learned in detail about the production of medical appliances.

Recalling that the Party had already given policies several times to remodel and modernize the units associated with leadership exploits of the great leaders including the Myohyangsan Medical Appliances Factory and turn them into model ones after the Seventh Congress of the Party by taking issue with the serious situation that the public health sector almost failed to do the work for

consolidating its material and technical foundation in recent years, he said he cannot but be very concerned about and disappointed by the bad situation of the factory. He noted that he could not understand whether the factory was under remodeling and modernization or not and what had been remodeled and modernized as he could not see any sign of remodeling though it has been two years since the Party gave a warning to it.

Other sectors have made remarkable leaps forward in recent years, but the public health sector has never done so but become more and more passive, he said, noting that there is nothing to be proud of in the public health sector, except the modern hospitals, the Medical Oxygen Factory and the Dental Hygiene Products Factory recently built under direct control of the Party. There is no unit keeping its environment well in the public health sector, to say nothing of equipment modernization, he charged.

The Party has stressed the need to intensify its guidance over the public health work and called for the Cabinet and the people's power organs at all levels to fully discharge their responsibility and role in the work for consolidating the material and technical foundation of the public health sector as the public health policy in our country is premised on the state investment and supply of materials, but officials are very idle and irresponsible in doing so, he pointed out.

The room for education in the revolutionary history is not so good in contrast with those of other units, and from the poor arrangement of the sci-tech learning space one can easily know with what ideological viewpoint the Party organizations in the public health sector accepted the Party policy on raising the hot wind of sci-tech study, and the hot wind for sci-tech learning can never be raised here, he said, criticizing the organizations for executing the Party policy in a very perfunctory manner.

He earnestly called for successfully turning the Myohyangsan Medical Appliances Factory, which President **Kim Il Sung** founded and paid deep attention to till the last moments of his life, into the model one playing the leading role in the industry of medical appliances to realize his wishes and glorify his leadership exploits down through generations.

It is necessary to stand in the van by destroying and transforming the outdated ones, not losing the heart, he said, adding that they should not repair some old buildings only but arrange the production environment, as required by the international standards, and modernize the production processes on the basis of the latest science and technology and turn the factory into the ultra-modern one capable of producing highly efficient quality medical equipment and appliances meeting the international standard.

He called for newly building the **Kimilsungism-Kimjongilism** Study Hall and the room for education in the revolutionary history, and sci-tech learning space,

products exhibition room and cultural and welfare facilities fashionably, and production buildings with scientific calculation, underlining the need to study the measures for radically improving the levels of domestic production, automation and modernization of medical appliances factories.

He stressed the need to turn medical appliances factories of the country into modern ones producing excellent medical facilities on the basis of advanced science and technology by making practical annual and stage plans of three to four years and dynamically pushing forward the work through strict reviews on the execution of the plans in order for the prospective development of the industry of medical appliances.

Calling on the officials and employees of the factory to turn out as one in the drive for its updating with consciousness of being the master, he said he would send the first Chollima of the public health sector to the factory, and encouraged them to take the lead in the public health sector and the industry of medical appliances of our country by riding on the Chollima.

Noting that he would personally shoulder the burden of the work of updating the factory, he detailed the orientation to carry out the tasks facing the relevant fields.

He was accompanied by Hwang Pyong So, first vice department director of the Central Committee of the Workers' Party of Korea; Jo Yong Won, Kim Yong Hwan, Pak Song Chol, O Il Jong and Kim Yong Su, vice department directors of the C.C., WPK; Kim Chang Son, department director of the State Affairs Commission; and Ma Won Chun, bureau director of the SAC.

Funeral Service for Kim Yong Chun Held

A state funeral for Marshal of the Korean People's Army Kim Yong Chun, member of the Central Committee of the Workers' Party of Korea, deputy to the DPRK Supreme People's Assembly and general adviser to the Ministry of the People's Armed Forces, solemnly took place here on Monday.

Kim Jong Un, chairman of the Workers' Party of Korea, chairman of the State Affairs Commission of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and supreme commander of the Korean People's Army, attended the ceremony of bidding the last farewell to the deceased.

There was a ceremony of carrying the coffin out of the April 25 House of Culture.

Members of the state funeral committee were on hand.

The coffin was carried out of the house amid the playing of the funeral music.

The armored car carrying the coffin left for the Patriotic Martyrs Cemetery in Sinmi-ri, escorted by motorcycles.

In streets of the capital including Pipha Street, Hasin Street and Ryonmot-dong, men and officers of the KPA and the Korean People's Internal Security Forces and Pyongyangites bid farewell to the deceased in deep sorrow.

A ceremony of bidding the last farewell to the deceased took place at the Patriotic Martyrs Cemetery in Sinmi-ri.

Supreme Leader of the Party, state and army **Kim Jong Un** climbed the cemetery with members of the state funeral committee following the coffin.

Army General Kim Su Gil, director of the KPA General Political Bureau, made a eulogy.

He said that the career of Kim Yong Chun was a glorious life in which he enjoyed the most worthy life as a revolutionary under the warm and special loving care of President **Kim Il Sung**, leader **Kim Jong Il** and Supreme Leader **Kim Jong Un** and a brilliant life of a prominent political activist and skilful military cadre who had faithfully upheld the idea and leadership of the Party with his transparent revolutionary faith in the forefront for defending the leader, the revolution and the country.

Although Marshal Kim Yong Chun passed away, his exploits will remain long in the history of the country, he stressed.

The remains of the deceased were buried amid the playing of funeral music and the firing of a volley for the deceased.

Kim Jong Un spread earth on the remains with his bitter mind as he lost the revolutionary comrade-in-arms intensely loyal to the Party.

Leading officials of the armed forces organs and bereaved family members spread earth on the remains.

Placed before the grave was a wreath bearing the august name of **Kim Jong Un**, wreaths in the names of the Central Committee and the Central Military Commission of the WPK, the Presidium of the DPRK Supreme People's Assembly and the DPRK Cabinet amid the playing of wreath-laying music.

Kim Jong Un observed a moment's silence in memory of Kim Yong Chun.
