

Kim Jong Un Visits Kumsusan Palace of Sun

Pyongyang, February 16 (KCNA) -- **Kim Jong Un**, chairman of the Workers' Party of Korea, chairman of the State Affairs Commission of the DPRK and supreme commander of the Korean People's Army, visited the Kumsusan Palace of the Sun at 00:00 on Feb. 16, the birth anniversary of leader **Kim Jong II** (the Day of the Shining Day), the national greatest auspicious holiday to pay high tribute to him.
