Kim Jong Un Meets Members of Delegation of Special Envoy of S. Korean President

Pyongyang, March 6 (KCNA) -- Respected Supreme Leader **Kim Jong Un**, chairman of the Workers' Party of Korea (WPK), chairman of the State Affairs Commission of the DPRK and supreme commander of the Korean People's Army, met members of the delegation of the special envoy of the south Korean president who arrived in Pyongyang on Monday.
