Great Statesman

Kim II Sung, the eternal President of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, was a great statesman who created a model of socialist public.

On the basis of the principle of the Juche Idea, he formulated an original people-centred socialist politics and brilliantly applied it. This is why the DPRK remained unperturbed even in the closing years of the last century, when socialism collapsed one after another in several countries that had been fettered to the conventional theory and formula based on the materialistic outlook on history.

Regarding independence as an unshakeable guideline in the revolution and construction, Kim II Sung consistently administered independence-based politics. He never vacillated in the slightest on the road of administering independence-based politics whoever may say what, and the greater the trials and hardships, the higher he held the banner of the Juche Idea. Under his leadership, the DPRK developed into a powerful nation that is independent in politics, self-sufficient in the economy and self-reliant in national defence.

Ever-victorious Iron-willed Commander

Kim II Sung, who defeated the Japanese imperialism and achieved the historic cause of Korea's liberation, was an ever-victorious iron-willed commander who humbled the arrogant U.S. imperialism, that had boasted of being the "strongest" in the world, in the Korean war(1950-1953)
