Kim Jong Un Visits Fatherland Liberation War Martyrs Cemetery

Respected Supreme Leader Kim Jong Un visited the Fatherland Liberation War Martyrs Cemetery on Thursday, the 64th anniversary of the Korean people's victory in the Fatherland Liberation War, and paid homage to the fallen fighters of the People's Army.
