



Kim Jong Un Meets Song Tao

Pyongyang, April 15 (KCNA) -- **Kim Jong Un**, chairman of the Workers' Party of Korea and chairman of the State Affairs Commission of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, on Saturday met with Song Tao, head of the International Liaison Department of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China who is on a visit to the DPRK leading the Chinese art troupe.
